

California TRUST Act (AB 4)

Signed into law on Oct. 5, 2013

NOTES:

Wobbler: A crime that can be charged as a felony or as a misdemeanor.

Misdemeanor DUI: ICE holds may NOT be responded to for misdemeanor DUI, only for felony DUI.

Straight misdemeanors: Crimes that are not wobblers or felonies. ICE holds may NOT be responded to if charges are only straight misdemeanors, even if listed in the TRUST Act.

Juveniles: ICE hold may only be responded to if current registrant on California Sex and Arson Registry, OR (1) 16 years of age and older and (2) convicted of a Cal. Wel. & Insti. 707(b) offense.
