DIRECTIVE 2014-11

ICE DETAINERS

Based upon a federal court decision and accompanied by a change of policy of the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department, the following will be effective immediately:

An ICE Detainer will no longer result in an additional hold and/or charge on a person who is arrested. It will not increase bail. It will not delay a person from being released when their open charges and/or warrants are resolved. In essence, it will have no effect on the status of a person we have arrested.

If we receive an ICE Detainer, it will be attached to the booking sheet for reference. It will not be listed on the booking sheet.

However, an exception to the above directive will be made if an ICE Detainer is accompanied with a signed and approved judicial probable cause declaration in support of the ICE Detainer for a violation of immigration laws. ICE is responsible for any such probable cause declaration and we will not attempt to obtain one. A probable cause declaration on the local charges has no effect on the ICE Detainer. They are two separate things. If an ICE Detainer meets these requirements, it can be used as an additional hold on the arrested person.
