Dear Mr. McMahon:

I received your letter to Sgt. Dave Lareva requesting the current protocol in place regarding the Ventura County Sheriff's Office response to ICE detainers for inmates in custody in our jail facilities. Subsequent to the recent Federal Court ruling, *U.S. District Court, Miranda-Olivares v. Clackamas County, Case No. 3:12-cv-02317-ST, issued April 11, 2014*, The Ventura County Sheriff's Office no longer detains inmates solely on ICE detainer requests. This protocol was put into place on June 1, 2014. Our protocol includes the following steps:

- Time/Date stamp ICE detainer requests.
- Mark the detainer request with a slash through the document and do not book the inmate.
- Place detainer request in the inmate's custody file.
